



TIS Busing Community Collective BEHAVIOURAL CONCERNS

Mana Coach Services have outlined some of the major behavioural problems that have occurred on their school bus services on a regular basis (not exclusively or necessarily including Tawa Intermediate School students):

- ✚ Tagging / Wilful damage
- ✚ Bullying
- ✚ Fighting
- ✚ Excessive use of the 'Bus Stopping' bell
- ✚ Lighting fires / Smoking
- ✚ Passenger fare discrepancy

Minor behavioural problems include loud, profane language and unnecessary movement around the bus.
